



A. Venue: Biswa Bangla Exhibition Centre.

- J. About the Venue: The ten-story Biswa Bangla Exhibition Centre opened in 2017 and has four banquet/exhibition rooms, two auditoriums, and a convention hall. There are 822 parking spots, as well as executive lounges, gyms, and swimming pools.
- **K. About the City:** Nestled along the eastern bank of the Hooghly River, Kolkata (formerly Calcutta) serves as the capital of the State of West Bengal in India.
