

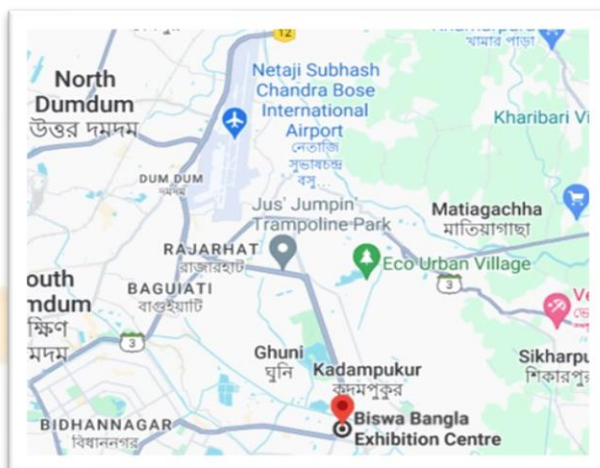

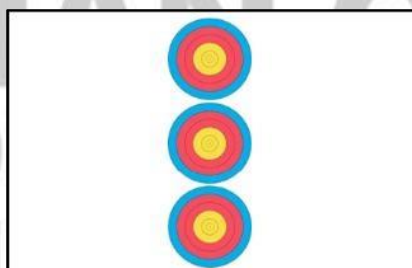
A. Venue: Biswa Bangla Exhibition Centre.

(HFJF+9G6, Canal Bank Rd, DG Block (Newtown), Action Area I, Newtown, West Bengal 700156).



B. Registration Period: 16th November 2023 to 15th January 2024.

C. Format: Indoor archery format with 40cm vertical target face at 18m distance.



D. Competition Rules: All other World Archery indoor rules apply.

- ii. **Elimination Round:** Top 64 archers in senior and top 32 archers in u-18 shall compete in the elimination round.

J. About the Venue: The ten-story Biswa Bangla Exhibition Centre opened in 2017 and has four banquet/exhibition rooms, two auditoriums, and a convention hall. There are 822 parking spots, as well as executive lounges, gyms, and swimming pools.

K. About the City: Nestled along the eastern bank of the Hooghly River, Kolkata (formerly Calcutta) serves as the capital of the State of West Bengal in India. Renowned for its history and culture, Kolkata was India's capital under the British rule from 1773-1911 and boasts the highest number of Nobel laureates among all cities in India. Often referred to as the "City of Joy", Kolkata stands as a testament to India's rich history and vibrant diversity.
